Application Procedure *	Students must submit the “Application Form” for Erasmus upon request of it to: erasmus@eacadiz.com
Documents to include	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application Form, completed and signed (fill in the computer not handwrite)*. • Letter of motivation* • CV (Europass)* • Portfolio (digital support) • Learning Agreement* • ID Card/ Passport and two photos • Spanish certificate confirming skills at minimum level in order to know you’ll be able to follow lectures and pass exams**. It would be recommended a minimum Spanish level in order to follow the lessons and exams <p>It is not compulsory a official certificate, the results of the assessment sent to the home institution with the level of the student after his/her selection with the Erasmus+ online assessment tool will be enough.</p>
Learning Agreement	No changes are allowed on the “Learning Agreement” after a month of the beginning of the semester

** May be sent before the student's arrival, if he doesn't have the recommended language level at the time of completion the application.
